



Sedation Discharge Instructions

We appreciate your commitment to your pet's health. The sedation your pet received today enabled us to complete the agreed upon procedure. Here is some information of what to expect for your pet's recovery:

- **Most pets do well after sedation.** If your pet does not, please let us know what is going on. Some may experience a lingering groggy demeanour and may not eat the first night, still you should offer a small amount of food and water. If they eat normally and still seem hungry, they can have a bit more.
- **Please keep an eye on your pet around stairs, chairs and beds.** Their judgement and balance may still be a bit off, and we don't want them to injure themselves trying to navigate what on a normal day is easy stuff.
- By the following morning we expect them to be back to their normal self. If they still seem off, or **if there is anything else that is concerning you we will gladly take a look!** There is no charge for this visit, but we do ask that you call ahead for an appointment - **250-371-3236**
